



Seeking members of the local community with an interest in Korongee

Glenview Community Services is currently building Korongee in Glenorchy. The Korongee village is a new approach to caring for people living with dementia and it is important to seek the perspectives of people living with dementia, their family members and friends, aged care staff and the broader community to inform planning. We want to explore the community's ideas about the care that will be delivered at Korongee.

Researchers at the Wicking Centre, in consultation with Glenview, are seeking input from people interested in the development of the model of care for the Korongee village. Members of the Glenorchy local community are invited to participate.

There are three ways you can participate: group meetings over online video calls; individual interviews in person, over the phone or using online video calls; or by providing written responses to some questions.
