
Rodney will have multiple high profile projects to oversee for Glenview, especially if our grant application for capital works at Windsor is successful.

Voluntary Enforceable Undertaking (VEU) progress

"We are well on our way to the end of the VEU which is a milestone in itself."

Work continues at Windsor with further consultation undertaken on Behaviour Support Plans for Residents.

The High Risk Resident Meeting continues to occur weekly and the clinical team will be evaluating this process in May.

Further education is planned for staff on managing changing behaviours, including education with Dementia Training Australia for the staff working in Waratah. We have had a recent external audit from Standards Wise Australia - thank you to everyone who participated in this audit and gave feedback to the independent auditors Nicole and Bette.

We are awaiting the final report but initial feedback has been very positive and the team will see a lot of great work underway across both sites.
